

The first World Heritage Day was celebrated in 1983, and since then, it has become an important event for promoting awareness about cultural heritage.

History of Heritage Day

The history of World Heritage Day can be traced back to 1982, when ICOMOS proposed April 18 as the International Day for Monuments and Sites. This event was followed by UNESCO's adoption of Heritage Day during its 22nd General Conference in 1983.

ICOMOS The organization was created based on the principles in the Venice Charter, also known the as 1964 International Charter on conservation and restoration of monuments and sites. Since then **ICOMOS** provides different theme annually celebrate World Heritage Day and educate the world about the same.
